Cathedral Renovations: Preparation work has begun on the installation of Glass Doors at the West end of the Cathedral, and the installation of a lift in the Crypt for people with disabilities – this work is almost complete. We are grateful for the donations which has made much of this work possible. You will notice that the peeling paint has been removed from the walls of the Cathedral (this is an interim measure as cannot afford to re-paint as yet!) Also the walls, windows and Stations have been cleaned and washed and the Pugin cobwebs removed! The cathedral floors have been scrubbed and buffed. Thank you for your patience. We are grateful to the Cathedral volunteers but need many more to help with the cleaning – even one morning or afternoon would be helpful. Please contact Canon Gerry if you can help. Our thanks to those who have responded so generously with donations – both great and small towards our renovations.

Electrical Maintenance & Repairs : Urgent Electrical maintenance & repair works are being carried out on site during the week beginning **Monday 15th April to Friday 19th April**. This will mean loss of power to the whole site which includes our Cathedral. Daily Masses and school tours will continue to take place, it will just be that we do not have the bright lights we usually have. We ask for your patience and understanding during this period in order to successfully carry out these **URGENT** repairs. Sincere apologies for the inconvenience caused.
