COLLECTING CONTACT DETAILS OF THOSE WHO COME TO CHURCH FOR NHS TRACK AND TRACE

For the safety of all who attend the Cathedral, the government has advised that a contact phone number be kept for everyone who comes to the Cathedral, for a period of 21 days. That information will be destroyed after 21 days. It will be made available to NHS Track and Trace if they contact the parish to request that information. It will only be made available to any third party if that is required by law.

If you come to the Cathedral in a group or as a family only one contact number will be needed.

The legal basis on which the parish will hold this information is your consent. If you do not wish to provide your phone number for these purposes, you will still be able to attend the Cathedral.

WE ASK THOSE COMING TO THE CATHEDRAL TO BRING A PIECE OF PAPER WITH THEIR NAME AND PHONE NUMBER WRITTEN ON IT AND PLACE IT IN THE CONTAINER PROVIDED FOR THIS PURPOSE.

IF SOMEONE WISHES TO ATTEND THE CATHEDRAL AND HAS NOT WRITTEN DOWN THEIR DETAILS BUT IS HAPPY TO PROVIDE THEM, A STEWARD MAY (WHILE OBSERVING SOCIAL DISTANCING) WRITE THOSE DETAILS DOWN AND PUT THEM IN THE CONTAINER.
