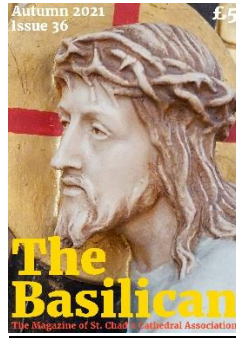


BASILICAN MAGAZINE
